The main responsibilities include practice planning and implementation, scheduling of practices and race calendar, race coverage, team communications, overseeing inventory of sport specific gear/uniforms, and driving team to practices/competitions. The ideal candidate should have extensive experience as a head coach and must possess excellent communication skills.

A qualified candidate will be able to manage the key responsibilities and tasks as listed below:

- Provide positive, safe, healthy, challenging and supportive experience for participants
- Identify, develop, and apply age and developmentally appropriate coaching methods
- Develop and implement daily practice plans and routines
- Plan practice and race schedules, and logistics for overnight trips
- Communicate team and program related information to coaches, athletes and parents effectively and in timely manner
- Communicate with athletic department staff effectively and in timely manner
- Attend meetings and trainings scheduled by the Athletic Director
