Discussion and resolution to dissolve surplus “future fund” through donation to PNSA.  
Estimated monies are \$303.17. ( Subject to final accounting ) Unanimous Approval.

Discussion of funding resource NCCSEF.

Nomination and election of NCC director. Steve Devin by unanimous approval.

Discussion of PNSA membership dues. All participating racing clubs need to pay annual  
dues.

Discussion of Coach’s Discretion clause. The use of the coach’s discretion for JO team  
selection should not be taken lightly, but rather used judiciously with good cause.

Tentative race calendar. Schedule races for Jan 6-7, Jan 19-21 Super JOQ @ Soldier  
Hollow, Feb 3-4, Feb 17-18 @ Mt Spokane. Bend, Leavenworth and Methow will  
check schedule for putting on race dates.

Summer camps. NEG camp – 4 girls ,3 boys selected to attend.

Share wax facilities with High Plains, Reserved townhouse rooms (11), Food to be  
catered in, 4 vans, jackets ordered Entry fee \$125. Wax budget -- \$2000. any shortfall  
from budget will be made up from team members .

Estimated costs \$900.

JOQ Qualifying Standards discussion. Proposed and resolved to 1) keep anomaly clause and 2) change to 8 % back ( from current 9 %) of average of top three places times as qualifying standard in 5 of 6 races. 5 approved, 2 abstained --- motion passed

Clarification of JOQ exemptions. Ben Husaby explained the exemption if an athlete is in the top 5 on the U.S. World Junior List

Discussion of Collegiate athletes qualifying standards for JO. Collegiate athletes would need to qualify in 4 JOQ races in the region and still need to petition for inclusion on the team.

Coaches clinic. Nathan Alsobrook asked for possible participation and consensus concerning a coaching clinic for the region. Interest was universal. He would look into setting one up for this season.

Technical Directors. Ben Husaby reiterated the need for qualified T.D.s, hoping to provide a clinic at Bend in the fall.

Award Nominations. TJ Owen will take to PNSA meeting in May.
